

CONTRACTORS NOTIFICATION

As required by law under the Hazard Communication Statute, Title 8, Sec 5194, of the California Administrative Code, we are here by notifying our contractors and their employees of hazardous materials or substances on site. *(Note: for state of California, check your states code numbers)*

(Company Name) has written and implemented a Hazard Communication Plan. There are procedures in place for handling hazardous materials or substances in this building. It is our contention that contractors and their employees understand those hazardous materials and substances are used and/or stored in this building. It is, however, the responsibility of the contractors to ensure that their employees are aware of the hazardous materials or substances used or stored in this building, and their potential contact information pertaining to hazardous materials or substances, in this building, to their employees as necessary. If illiteracy is a problem for said contractor's employees, the contractors then have the responsibility to read this notification and any other pertinent Hazard Communication information to their employees. It is the responsibility of the contractors to supply and provide any necessary or required Personal Protective Equipment to their employees. Also, it is the responsibility of the contractors and their employees to inquire about, and wear, any Personal Protective Equipment that is, or may be required in this building. Furthermore, it is the responsibility of the contractors and their employees to follow all safety rules pertaining not only to hazardous materials and substances, but to safety in general in this building. These safety rules are available upon request.
